It is required that the School provide adequate space for instruction. A minimum of 20' x 20' (400 sq feet) is recommended to ensure proper instruction of techniques. If this space is not available, the Venue acknowledges that the Seminar will be adapted to work in the space provided.

Techniques in our Seminars typically involve a mix of hapkido and tae kwon do including:

- Escapes from grabs
- Escapes from chokes
- Defense and counter strikes against punches
- Defense and counter strikes against kicks
- Defense and counter strikes against knife attacks
- Escort and immobilization techniques

If there is an interest in having any specific technique(s) demonstrated, it must be put in writing and submitted to the Institute no less than 2 weeks prior to the event. If adequate time is not given, proper practice of the technique(s) for the seminar will not be possible and it will not be included.

Cost is a flat fee for Seminars lasting up to 2 hours and is \$250 paid in advance. Seminars that are ½ day (4 hours) are \$500 and full-day seminars (7 hours) are \$750. Forms of acceptable payment include check, cashier's check, money order, credit card, or cash.
